- Tech Your Vehicle Once, Fill Out The Appropriate Paperwork & You No Longer Have To bring Your Vehicle To Tech Inspection Before Each Event. Just Bring Your Tech Card, ATI Form & Driver's License!
- Vehicle Must Have Their 4 Digit Driver Number (IRRA number on license) Fixed To The Top Left Corner Of The Front & Rear Windshield. Numbers Must Be White And 4" Tall.

The ATI Is Valid At The Following Places:

1. All IRRA Events
 2. All Street Warriorz Events
 3. All PBIR Sanctioned Test & Tunes & Events
- You Must Have A Valid IRRA License To Be Eligible To Participate In The Street Car ATI Program

IRRA Motorsports Annual Technical Inspection (ATI) Program

This IRRA Motorsports (ATI) program is offered at no charge to all IRRA Licensed members as an alternative to the current event inspection process. It is designed to be an avenue for a detailed inspection that is also conducive to efficient event operations. It is specifically tailored towards customers who utilize the same vehicle at events throughout the season. The ATI is not considered a replacement or alternative to the standard waiver and release system.

Guidelines and Eligibility Requirements

- Current IRRA membership and license mandatory for all applicants.
- The competitor must present the (ATI) Inspection record at all events prior to competition.
- All ATI Inspections expire on December 31 of each calendar year, provided the records are adhered to and the vehicle and related drivers accessories remain in “as inspected “form. (All SFI expiration dates must be enforced)
- If the vehicle is updated or altered, a new inspection must be performed with appropriate documentation and a new inspection decal installed prior to competition.
- If any vehicle or competitor is found to be in violation of IRRA Rulebook regulations or ATI program requirements, further participation is prohibited.
